

How KVC West Virginia Helps Children & Families



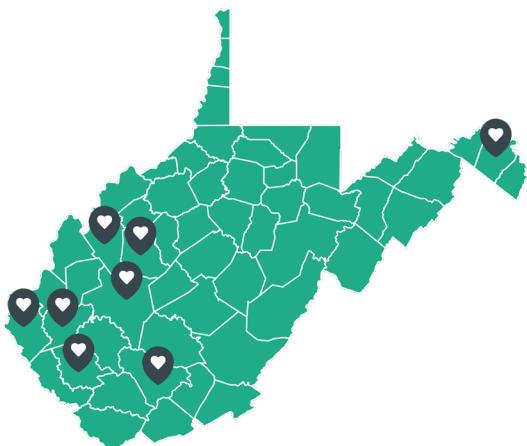
