RECOMMENDED RESOLUTION: Resolved, that the Fairmont State University

Board of Governors approve a budget increase for the Shaw House in the amount of \$8,525 for additional furnishings and interior

decorating.

BACKGROUND:

The project will rearrange and add furnishings to the entry hall, living room, dining room, and the three restrooms on the main floor of the Shaw House to enhance its use as a residence and for social gatherings.

Financial Report

Fairmont State University
Unrestricted Fund
For the period ending August 29, 2008

The budget plan for the Unrestricted Fund for the University improved slightly for the time period between July 30th and August 29th.

Revenues increased by \$39,196 as a result of changes in two areas. They are:

- The cancellation of President Bradley's Deferred Compensation Plan with the Foundation which added \$27,500 back to the Business Services Reimbursement line item of the Foundation's non-state funded budget. Note: funds received from the Foundation for Business Services reimbursement are categorized as other Operating Revenue.
- The remainder of the revenue budget increase was primarily due to increases in chargeback revenue budget adjustment in the operating costs and support services lines.

Budgeted operating expenses reflect an overall increase of \$18,709. The primary change to the operating expense budget was due to a change to the base contract of the President of \$15,432 which was covered by the increase in Business Services Reimbursement Revenue mentioned above.

During the month of September we expect to determine the final enrollment condition of the University for the Fall Semester and what impact this has on our student fee revenue budget. This information along with the enrollments in the Community and Technical College will determine any change to the chargeback budgets that must occur. Our plan is to update these budgets and provide another update of our University Unrestricted Budget for purpose of helping determine the availability of budget for pay raises.

For the period ending August 29th, 2008

The budget plan for the Auxiliary Funds for the period thru August 29, 2008 is balanced with \$637,179 planned to be transferred to auxiliary plant reserve at the end of FY 2009.

We are currently monitoring enrollments to both the University and the Community and Technical College for the Fall Semester. Both enrollments contribute to <u>all student auxiliary revenues</u>, and have an impact on our ability to meet debt service and operating costs. Our plan is to update the revenue budgets based on revenue received compared to revenues received against budget last year. Once budget is adjusted we will determine the availability of budget for a pay raise.

Financial Report

FAIRMONT STATE UNIVERSITY Restricted Funds for the period ending August 29, 2008

Revenues:

Revenues decreased by (\$408,648.88). This decrease was mainly due to the Gear Up receivable for FY 08 of (\$590,562.47) being posted in August 2008. The difference in the above two numbers was due to the FY 09 Dept. of Highways grant budget (\$167,528) and an addition to the PDS Partnership Grant budget entry (\$10,000), and other minor revenue budget adjustments.

Expenditures:

Expenditures increased by \$442,269.49. This increase was largely due to the Federal Work study budget for \$274,724.60, the Dept. of Highways budget of \$142,168.12 and other budget adjustments net of \$25,376.77 due to FY 08 audit entries updating restricted funds and other minor grant adjustments.

There was a \$686,246.99 restricted fund cash balance on June 30, 2008 covering planned expenditures in FY 2009 for funds received in FY 2008 (\$600,821.94).

<u>Capital Project Update:</u> August 2008

Upper practice field – The first half of this area has been seeded. With drought that we have experienced in the last month, we have delayed additional work until weather is more advantageous for grass growth.

Tennis Courts – This project will be advertised in Feb/March 2009 for a late May 2009 time frame for completion. Work scope has been prepared and project was ready to advertise for bids, but team schedules would not allow work to take place this fall.

Education Building roof and waterproofing – Physical plant is putting together information for Expression of Interests for architects.

Feaster Center classroom walls – Folding walls have been relocated and permanent wall has been installed. New data cabling has not been installed.

Feaster Center Elevator – Project has bid and architect is to submit recommendation to award project to low bidder. Available budget will cover base bid and leave a contingency to cover unforeseen issues.

Feaster Center HVAC – Project will be advertised for bidding within a few weeks.

Feaster Center pool painting – Cleaning and repainting of pool has been completed. Pool has been refilled and chemical system has been re-started. New lane dividers are in pool. Physical plant is repainting starting blocks and will repaint several walls to remove FSC and older falcons.

Folk Life Center – Contractor has replaced roof and is removing concrete slabs and has started framing work to support roof structure.

Locust Avenue – FSU and WVDOH are waiting for Allegheny Power to confirm final routing and associated costs.

College apt roof replacement – Roof work is complete and area has been reseeded. This project is complete.

College apt wall replacement – Designs of the walls are complete. Physical Plant is reviewing budget to determine best approach for the available dollars.

Residence halls furniture, boiler, egress exits and floor covering—Furniture and floor covering were completed for the start of the school year. Delayed egress exits and boiler remain to be completed.

Hunt Haught Hall painting – This project is complete. Floors were waxed as areas were completed before faculty re-occupied this space.

Physical Plant small projects – Several projects have been completed. There will be many throughout the year.
