Shared Courses Policy

Effective Date: December 15, 2005

Revised: April 5, 2007

It is the policy of the Fairmont State University Board of Governors that the academic units of Fairmont State University (the Undergraduate/Graduate and C&TC units) share lower division and developmental courses to the greatest extent possible. The goal of this policy is to control costs, maximize flexibility for students and minimize issues relating to transfer of credits.

The Board of Governors charges the presidents with developing and maintaining a shared course list. The presidents will report annually on the shared course list and explain course duplication if any exists.
