MHCM 6100 Applied Research	<p><i>Students admitted in the fall cohort start MHC 5100 and 5200, etc. to follow sequence for Foundation courses (yellow). Students starting in the spring cohort begin with MHCM 5300, 5400 or 5810 as foundation courses with electives as desired. Students must complete foundation courses (15 credits) and 21 elective courses to graduate. Courses in yellow are foundations courses and then the student chooses 21 credits from electives in Blue.</i></p> <p><i>**For AIT Part 1, this is now a regular 3 credit elective taken any student as it is an overview of the regulation and operation of post-acute care facilities (Title to be changed in future). Any student wishing to pursue a nursing home administrator's license must take MHCM 6020, but prior to enrolling, the facility preceptor must be identified in MHCM 6010 in advance for WV Nursing Home Administrator's Licensing Board approval. MHCM 6020 is the 250 hours internship at a nursing home which much be arranged, requires pre-planning and prior approval from the WVNHALB. When completed, the students apply for approval to take the state licensure examination. This takes a lot of coordination as the WVNHALB only approves these at their quarterly board meetings. These are done directly to the WVNHALB with advisor guidance. The internship (6020) is only arranged when the student has been approved and can also be in the summer. Student can take both courses in a semester or complete the residency over the summer.</i></p>
