PROGRAM OF STUDY

The M.Ed. in Professional Studies provides professionals with an opportunity to design a program of study customized to meet their professional and personal interests. Students complete the 9 core credit hours (3 core courses) required for all M.Ed. candidates and then consult with a faculty advisor to select an additional 21 credit hours (7 courses) from a variety of graduate course offerings to complete their individual course plan.
