I recommend approval of the attached Curriculum Proposal #12-13-13 from the School of Business.

This proposal reduces the total hours needed for a B.S. in Accounting degree from 128 hours to 120 hours beginning Fall 2013, and incorporates the new General Studies curriculum into the degree requirements. The effect of the proposed change includes the incorporation of 15 hours of courses from the Business Core to satisfy select attributes of the General Studies curriculum.
