This degree does not comply with the 120 hour mandate set by HEPC. This is due to certification requirements set by the West Virginia Department of Education. The Approved Teacher Education program in Music Education must comply with these requirements in able for our students to successfully pass licensure examinations (i.e. Praxis II) at the state and national levels. Please consult the 2012 Curriculum Assessment Report (CAR) on file with the School of Education for specific content criteria and curriculum standards.

The FSU School of Education is planning to petition for a waiver for all Education degree programs to be exempt from the 120 credit hour requirement at a later date.
