In order to come into compliance with the 120 credits for the Allied Health Administration bachelor of science degree, we propose that the elective credits be reduced from 20 to 14-15 credits. Additionally, since INFO 1100, Computer Concepts and Applications, is being deleted as a course offering, it will be replaced with BISM 1200, Introduction to Computing, since it is a required prerequisite for BISM 2800, Corporate Communications and Technology.
