Current Course Description (will not change other than prerequisites):

NURS 3350 Professional Nursing Concepts....3 hrs.

This course is designed to introduce the concepts of professional nursing practice and the nurse generalist role. Students explore the healthcare context, health policy, and political action. The core health care competencies, as identified by the Institute of Medicine, are examined. Topics include patient-centered care, interprofessional teams, evidence-based practice, quality improvement, and informatics. The scope of the coursework covers the history, current state, and future of nursing in order to prepare registered nurses for diverse and dynamic professional roles (3 class hours per week). PR: Admission to the BSN program and NURS 3320; NURS 3320 may be taken concurrently. Active, unencumbered nursing license required. Fall semester only.

Proposed Course Description

NURS 3350 Professional Nursing Concepts....3 hrs.

Writing Intensive

This course is designed to introduce the concepts of professional nursing practice and the nurse generalist role. Students explore the healthcare context, health policy, and political action. The core health care competencies, as identified by the Institute of Medicine, are examined. Topics include patient-centered care, interprofessional teams, evidence-based practice, quality improvement, and informatics. The scope of the coursework covers the history, current state, and future of nursing in order to prepare registered nurses for diverse and dynamic professional roles (3 class hours per week). PR: Admission to the BSN program, ENGL 1108, and NURS 3320; ENGL 1108 and NURS 3320 may be taken concurrently. Active, unencumbered nursing license required. Fall semester only.
