I recommend approval of the attached Curriculum Proposal #12-13-52 from the School of Education, Health & Human Performance.

This proposal reduces the credit hours required for the BA Degree in Elementary Education from 132 hours to 123 hours and incorporates new requirements for General Studies. The degree cannot be reduced to the 120 hour mark due to Policy 5100 and the PRAXIS Content Test Series which prescribe specific courses and content that elementary program candidates must take.
